

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN No. _____

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed by Th. Thomas Himmelson to The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company of Philadelphia, secured by a Mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina dated March 1, 1924 and recorded in said County on March 1 1924 in Volume 126 of Mortgages Page 21 the sum of \$650.00 (sixty five hundred) Dollars, with interest from March 1 1924; and,

WHEREAS, title to the above mentioned real estate is now vested in Walter P. Bull subject to said Mortgage; and,

WHEREAS, the Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided:—

NOW THEREFORE, the Insurance Company hereby extends the time of payment of said note so that it shall be due and payable as hereinafter provided, and said Walter P. Bull hereby agree, jointly and severally, to pay the principal sum remaining due, as aforesaid, as follows:

\$250.00 September 1, 1924; \$200.00 on the first days of March and September, 1925, 1926, 1927, 1928; balance on March 1, 1924 with the privilege of paying any amount of the principal balance remaining due on any interest paying date. with interest thereon from March 1, 1924 until said principal shall be fully paid, at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to the above extension and agree that said Mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

IT IS AGREED that the Statute of Limitations shall not begin to run against the note or said Mortgage before the end of said extended period.
