WHEREAS, I, the said Murphy S. Merritt

Dollars, to be paid in three equal annual installments, the first  
installment to be due twelve (12) months after  
date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will

the County and State aforesaid, fronting on Washing-  
ton Avenue, and being known and designated as  
Lot No. 14 on Plat of property made by R. E. Dalton, Eng-

Beginning at a joint corner of Lots 15 and 14, and run-  
ning along Washington Avenue S. 26-06 E. 114.6 feet to a stake;
