at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Polze Babb, Attorney, and his

successors and assigns forever:  
"All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate,  
lying and being in Greenville Township, located on  
the north side of Parker Road about two and one-half  
miles of Greenville County Court House and being  
known and designated as Tract no. 2 of the property  
of the Estate of J. C. Martin, deceased, plat January  
12, 1929, made by C. M. Furman, Jr. and containing  
Six (6) acres, more or less.  
"Beginning at a pin in the center of Parker  
Road joint corner of Tracts nos. One and Two  
and running thence with line of tract no. One  
N. 44 E. 12.20 chains to joint rear line of said  
Tracts One and Two; thence N. 15 E. 16.8 chains,  
thence S. 80.15 W. 1.38 chains; thence N. 55 E. 30'20.  
180 chains to rear of joint corner of tracts Two  
and Three; thence S. 51.35 W. 1236 chains with line  
of tract no. Three to pin in center of Parker Road;  
thence with center of said road S. 59.45 E. 6.06
