SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *we*, the said *D. B. Pittman and Flora Mae Pittman*
in and by *my* certain *premissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

A. L. Pittman, Tigerville, S. C.
in the full and just sum of *Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date, Dec. 5, 1936*

with interest thereon, from *date, Dec. 5, 1936* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *we* the said *D. B. Pittman and Flora Mae Pittman*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

A. L. Pittman
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *A. L. Pittman.*

All that certain tract of land lying and being in Highland Township and
Greenville County and in the State of South Carolina, & being a part of the Dill land
deeded to Pearl Robertson and to myself, lying on the north side of the ridge road
leading to Tigerville. Beginning on a stake on E. F. Neves, corner, and running with
B. F. Neves, line and with the old road to a stone; thence S. 88 1/2 W. 7.75 to willow
stump on the branch thence with the branch as the line 11.50 chains to a willow stake
thence S. 63 W. 6.10 to an iron pin; thence S. 5 E. 3.28 to an iron pin thence S. 33 E.
6.00 to an iron pin; thence S. 48 W. 5.35 to a point in the ridge road; thence down the
old ridge road, the old road way to the beginning corner, containing eighteen acres, more
or less, and joined by lands of A. L. Pittman, B. F. Neves and others.
