Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Augusta Road, at the corner of lot no. 7, 266 feet from Henrietta Street, on the west side of Augusta Street, thence running with the line of lot no. 7, S. 53-33 E. 276.8 feet to a pin on the line of lot no. 9, thence with the line of lots nos. 9 and 16, N. 36-24 E. 90 feet to the corner of lot no. 5, thence with the line of lot no. 5, N. 53-33 E. 276.7 feet to Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road, S. 30-34 E. 90 feet to the beginning corner, being a part of the land conveyed to me the said G.
