

Agreement for Monthly Instalment Extension of Loan No. 197 539-3

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA by Essie Inman secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated December 21, 1936, and filed for record in said County on December 21, 1936, in Volume 172 of Mortgages on Page 19, the sum of Sixty-nine Hundred Twenty (\$6,920.00) Dollars, with interest from December 21, 1936, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Essie Inman subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Essie Inman hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

On the first day of each month, beginning on the first day of February, 1939, the sum of Forty & no/100 (\$40.00) Dollars, to be applied on the principal of said amount due on said note, and also at the same times, interest at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum on the balances of said principal remaining due thereon on the said first day of each month, and on the first day of December, 1946, the balance of said principal sum with interest thereon; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

Additional payments in multiples of the monthly instalment of principal, may be made on the principal at any interest payment date, and the amount so paid shall be credited on said principal. Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal of this indebtedness on any date when interest becomes due and payable, provided, however, that such payments shall be in multiples of the monthly payment on account of principal herein provided for, and provided further that prior to five years from date the amount so paid during any year, ending at an anniversary of the date from which interest accrues hereunder, added to obligatory principal payments falling due within such one year period, shall not exceed one-fifth of the principal sum payable under the terms of this instrument (303) and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

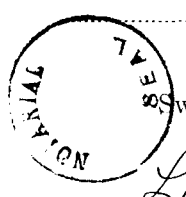
