

Agreement for Monthly Instalment Extension of Loan No. 251231-A

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered to THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA by Emmaus J. Blighton secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated November 9th 1938, and filed for record in said County on November 9th, 1938, in Volume 123 of Mortgages on Page 60, the sum of One Thousand and Forty (\$1,040.00) Dollars, with interest from November 1st, 1938, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in P. L. Brownville subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said P. L. Brownville hereby agrees to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

On the first day of each month, beginning on the first day of December, 1938, the sum of Thirteen (\$13.00) Dollars, to be applied on the principal of said amount due on said note, and also, at the first day of each month hereafter, six per cent. per annum on the balances of said principal remaining due thereon on the said

first day of each month, and on the first day of July, 1945, the balance of said principal sum with interest thereon; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note. Additional payments in multiples of the monthly instalment of principal, may be made on the principal at any interest payment date, and the amount so paid shall be credited on said principal. Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal of this indebtedness on any date when interest becomes due and payable, provided however, that such payments shall be in multiples of the monthly payment on account of principal herein provided for; and provided further that prior to five years from date the amount so paid during any year ending at any anniversary of the date from which interest accrues hereunder, shall not exceed one-fifth of the principal sum payable under the terms of this instrument. And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises,

and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
