For a consideration of Value Received (\$) Dollars, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of that certain mortgage hereinafter described, and the note which same was given to secure, held pursuant to the Acts of Congress, known as Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act and Farm Credit Act of 1935, (Sections 1016 g and 1020 f, Title 12 U. S. C.) by and through The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its agent and attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress, known as Farm Credit Act of 1935, (Section 1016 L, Title 12 U. S. C.), without recourse or liability of any kind or nature, express or implied, does hereby transfer, set over and assign unto O. S. Black, his heirs and assigns, all its rights, titles and interest in and to that certain mortgage from Mrs Carrie M. Black, to the Land Bank Commission, dated August 2, 1934, and recorded in the public records of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 239, at page 121, and the indebtedness secured thereby which is evidenced by an amortization note of the same date.

It is understood that the instrument assigned and for the lien securing it is subject to subordination and non-disturbance agreement executed by the undersigned in favor of the Governor of the Farm Credit Administration and agencies under his supervision, and is subject to any agreement with local production credit associations covering distribution and proration of proceeds of crops produced on mortgaged property.
