in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Nineteen Thousand Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum to be repaid in installments of Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) Dollars,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, (on) the Western side of Keevree Avenue, being shown as Lot 30, Block 10 on plat of "North Greenville Park" made by Broome &amp; Bell Engineers in July 1913, recorded in the P. M. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "B" at page 96, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit: #10274
