STIPULATION AMENDING CORPORATION

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 13 day of April, 1939, by and between Broadus Durant and Nancy Thermond Durant, his wife, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor(s), and the United States of America, hereinafter called the Mortgagee;

WITNESSETH: THAT,

WHEREAS, on October 3, 1938, the Mortgagor(s) executed to the Mortgage a certain real estate mortgage covering the following described land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Hownship, about 7 miles East of the City of Greenville, on held waters of Rocky Creek Waters of Enorde River, known and designated as tracts 1 and 2 of S. L. Velighn Faym, shown on plat therof made by W. S. Baldwin, dated October 19, 1918, recorded in R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book E, page 110, and having, a ccording to such blat the following metes and bounds, to wit: Englinning at an iron pin corner of W. M. Watson's land, and running thence N. 84 E. 17.62 chains to inon pin; thence N. 6 W. 17.20 chains to an illing pin; thence N. 76 W. 23.06 chains to iron pin center road; thence S. 52½ W. along said road 2 17 chains to iron pin; thence N. 78 W. 11.82 chains to iron pin at road; thence S. 9 W. shond said bood 2 1/34 chains to iron pin at intersection of roads; thence S. 11-5/8 E. 19 chains to beginning corner, and containing 75-3/4 acres, and being the same tract conveyed to Alice Green by S. L. Vrugh by deed dated December 23, 1918, and recorded in Volume 34, page 109, which most gape was recorded in Book 276, page 133, in the coffice of the Reguster of Mesne Conveyancy Greenville County South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the parties herete desire to amend said mortgage so as to let forth the trive intent of the parties thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the first paragraph of said mortgage shall be, and the same is hereby amended to read as roll ows.

"THAT WHEREAS, the indeptigned Broadus Durant and Nandy Mermend Durant, his wife, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagor (s) (have become justly indebted to the United States of America, acting by and through the Secretary of Agriculture, pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm activater inafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by one certain promissory note dated the 20 day of September, 1938, for the principal sum of Three thusand eight hundred twenty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$5025.00), with interest at the rate of three per cent (3%) per annum principal and interest payable and amortized in installments as therein provided, the first installment of One hundred sixty-five and 47/100 Dollars (\$165.47) being due and collectible on the 31 day of December, 1938, the next succeeding thirty-eight installments annually thereafter, and the Nortieth installment either thirty-nine years thereafter or forty years from the date of said note, whichever date is the earlier; and"

It is further agreed that all other terms and conditions of said mortgage shall continue in full force and effect.
