SEND GREETINGS

WHEREAS I the said R. H. Parker

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am we and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100

(\$ 2,500.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/100

(\$ 25.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; and note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R. H. Parker

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Gantt Township, on the west side of Augusta Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1, of the Estate of Mrs. S. C. Mills, as shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle, July 12, 1938, containing 2.10 acres, more or less, and having, according to the aforesaid plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin, which pin is the joint corner of this property and lands of Kind and Harris, and running thence along line of Harris' property, S. 86-22 E. 279.5 feet to a point in the Augusta Road; thence along the line of said Augusta Road, N. 1-02 W. 437.6 feet to a point in said Augusta Road; thence S. 85-38 W. 147 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-15 W. 428 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Piedmont Corporation by deed dated Jan. 25, 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 208, page 230."
