with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent. of the amount due

Hers and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid,

on Charles Street, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 34, Block 1, of Newland, as shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 199, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on Charles Street at corner of Lot No. 33, and running thence S. 43-12 W. 50 feet along Charles Street to a stake at corner of lots Nos. 34 and 35; thence along line of Lot No. 35, N. 46-48 W. 150 feet to stake at corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 35; thence N. 43-12 E. 50 feet to stake, corner of Lot No. 33; thence along line of Lot No. 33, S. 46-48 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner; this being the same property conveyed to H.
