SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~

~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred Fifty
and no/100 (\$ 750.00) DOLLARS, The Peoples National Bank of Greenville in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date
hereof until maturity at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable monthly
installments as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of October, 1939, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 7.50, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to in-
cluding the 1st day of March, 1951 and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of April
1951; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 7.50 to be applied first to interest at the rate
of six (6%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 750.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid
and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment
of any installment or installments, or any part thereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the
rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant
contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and fore-
close this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it
should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the
hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including (10%) per cent,
of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on a plat of Section 1 of Judson Mills Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in August, 1939, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book K, at pages 11 and 12, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of the intersection of 3rd Avenue and Goodrich Street and running thence with 3rd Avenue S. 4-30 W. 95 feet to an iron pipe, joint front
corner of lots No. 1 and 2; thence with the line of lot No. 2, S. 85-30 E. 128.4 feet to an iron pipe on the Southwest side of Goodrich Street; thence with Goodrich Street N. 49-02 W.
159.6 feet to the beginning corner.
