I, (Miss) Grace Meadors, of Greenville, S. C.,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said (Miss) Grace Meadors

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to  
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of TWO THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED  
AND NO/100

( \$ 2,600.00 ) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of TWENTY-SIX AND NO/100  
(\$ 26.00 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said (Miss) Grace Meadors

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND  
LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me  
the said (Miss) Grace Meadors

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 34, on plat of the property of Overbrook Land Company, as made Sept. 17, 1913, by H. Olin Jones, Engineer, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 252, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the southern line of East North Street Extension, at joint corner of Lots 33 and 34, which point is approximately 190.2 feet in a northerly direction from the intersection of Spruce street with East North Street Extension, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots 33 and 34, S. 35-30 E. 175.2 feet to a stake on the northern line of a 10-foot alley; thence along the northern line of said alley, N. 64-59 E. 64 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 34 and 35; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 30-33 W. 167.2 feet to a stake on the southern line of said East North Street Extension, which point is approximately 163.8 feet in a southerly direction from the intersection of East North Street Extension with Balsam Road; thence along the southern side of said East North Street Extension, S. 69-15 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Mrs. Kate Weir Wynne by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
