WHEREAS, I the said Earl Burrell

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to Judson Mills
~~Judson Mills~~, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Nine Hundred and no/100
The Peoples National Bank of Greenville
 (\$ 900.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at the rate of six (6 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly
 hereof until maturity at the rate of six (6 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly
 installments as follows:
 Beginning on the 1st day of October 1939 and on the 1st day of each month
 of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 9.00, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to in-
 cluding the 1st day of March, 1951 and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of April
1951; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 9.00 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate
 of six (6 %) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 900.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid
 and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part thereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 11 and 12, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the West side of 4th Avenue, 52 feet South of the South-west corner of the intersection of 4th Avenue and Goodrich Street, being the joint corner of lots No. 26 and 27, and running thence with 4th Avenue S. 4-30 W. 70 feet to an iron pipe, joint corner of lots 27 and 28; thence with the line of lot No. 28, N. 85-30 W. 89.7 feet to an iron pipe, joint rear corner of lots No. 50 and 51; thence with the rear line of lot No. 51, N. 4-30 E. 70 feet to an iron pipe, joint rear corner of lots 26, 27, 51 and 52; thence with the line of lot No. 26, S. 85-30 E. 89.7 feet to the beginning point.
