with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

BEGINNING at a stake on the southeast side of Atwood St. on north corner of lot #2 (which stake in approximately 210 ft. from Marshall Ave.) and running thence along said Atwood St. N. 48 E. 65 ft. to a stake on corner lot #4; thence with line last mentioned lot S. 42 E. 159 ft. to a stake in line of land of estate of Mrs. Ann E.
