I, **S. I. James, of Greenville County, South Carolina**

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I _____ the said **S. I. James**

in and by my _____ certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am _____ well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of **THIRTEEN HUNDRED & NO/100**

(\$ **1300.00**) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of **THIRTEEN & NO/100**

(\$ **13.00**) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, on the East side of Virginia Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 59 on plat of subdivision of Property of J. M. Harris know as "Highland", recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 146, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin on the East side of Virginia Avenue, corner of Lot No. 58, and running thence with the line of said lot in an Easterly direction 130 feet to an iron pin in line of the Jones West Property; thence with the line of said property, N. 15-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot No. 60; thence with the line of said lot in a Westerly direction 130 feet to an iron pin on Virginia Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Virginia Avenue, S. 15-10 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to S. I. James by Lidie M. Machen by deed dated January 18, 1940, and recorded herewith.
