Brewton Temple Baptist Church, of Greenville County, S. C.,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS ~~x~~ the said Brewton Temple Baptist Church

in and by ~~its~~ certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, ~~is~~ well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of FIFTEEN HUNDRED & NO/100 (\$ 1500.00 ) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of FIFTEEN & NO/100

(\$15.00 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That ~~ix~~ the said Brewton Temple Baptist Church

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to ~~xxx~~ it the said Brewton Temple Baptist Church

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Old Paris Mountain Road and Oak Street, being shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of Property of E. E. Watson made by C. M. Furman, Jr., C. E., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 11, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake at the Northeast intersection of Old Paris Mountain Road and Oak Street and running thence with the Northern side of Oak Street, N. 72 E. 120 feet to corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of said lot, N. 18 W. 40 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of said lot, S. 72 W. 120 feet to a stake on Old Paris Mountain Road; thence with the Eastern side of Old Paris Mountain Road, S. 18 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to the Trustees of Brewton Temple Baptist Church by E. E. Watson by deed dated August 19, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds 87 at page 330, and the same lot upon which the church building is now located.

This mortgage is executed pursuant to a resolution adopted by the members of Brewton Temple Baptist Church at a meeting duly noticed and convened on the 4th. day of August, 1940.

And the mortgagor(s) do(es) hereby agree, on demand of the mortgagee at any time, to pay, on the first day of each succeeding month thereafter, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest stated above, a sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12th) of the said sum, taxes, assessment and insurance premiums, as estimated by the mortgagee. The mortgagor(s) further agree(s) to pay on demand, at any time, any additional sums necessary to pay these items. It is further agreed that any such additional payments, when so demanded by the mortgagee, shall become a part of the monthly installments due under the terms of this mortgage and the note secured thereby.
