SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said Clyde Batson

in and by MY certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to South Carolina National Bank

in the full and just sum of Six Hundred and eighty-nine and 88/100 (\$689.88)

(\$19.17) Dollars, to be paid in monthly installments of \$19.17 each, on the 15th day of each month, commencing with the 15th day of February, 1941, and continuing for 35 consecutive months, and a final payment of \$18.93 on the 15th day of March, 1944.

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually
