I, W. P. Bull

SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said W. P. Bull

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am

well and truly indebted to South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, a Corporation

in the full and just sum of Six thousand and no/100

Dollars, to be paid as follows: The sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars on the first day of February, 1941, and the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars on the first day of each and every month thereafter until the principal sum is paid in full.

with interest thereon from at the rate of 5 percentum, per annum to be computed and paid

monthly on the first day of each and every month interest at same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, a Corporation, its successors and assigns forever:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land on the South side of West Coffee Street in City of Greenville County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to a survey thereof made by R. B. Dalton, Engineer, February, 1937, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on South side of West Coffee Street, which point is 87 feet, 2 inches West from Southwest corner of the intersection of West Coffee and Laurens Streets, and running thence South side of West Coffee Street, N. 68-12 W. 26 feet 3 1/2 inches to a point in the center of a brick party wall; thence with the center of said brick party wall S. 22-19 W. 88 feet, 5 inches to a point in the center of said wall; thence S. 68-12 E. 26 feet, 10 1/2 inches to a point; thence N. 22-39 E. 9 feet, 2 1/2 inches to a point; thence N. 21-54 E. 79 feet, 2 1/2 inches to the South side of West Coffee Street, the beginning corner."
