I, **Charles E. Edwards**

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston (Columbia Branch)**

organized and existing under the laws of **United States of America**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Two Thousand Five Hundred** Dollars (\$2,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum (4 1/2 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston (Columbia Branch) in Columbia, S. C.**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Nineteen and 13/100** Dollars (\$19.13), commencing on the first day of **April** 1941, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **March** 1956.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the east side of Brookway Drive, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 27 in Block C on revised plat of Grove Park made by W. J. Riddle, April, 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book J, at pages 68 and 69, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, January 21, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

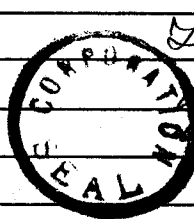
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Brookway Drive, joint front corner of Lots No. 26 and 27 of Block C, said pin being 275 1/3 feet in a northerly direction from the northeast corner of the intersection of Brookway Drive and a 28 foot unnamed street; thence with the line of Lot No. 26, N. 36-32 E. 94.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear lines of Lots No. 3, 4, 5 and 6, N. 59-15 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36-32 W. 5.6 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Brookway Drive; thence with the east side of Brookway Drive, S. 14-57 E. 127.1 feet to the beginning corner.
