all that tract or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

having according to an old survey the following metes and bounds, as described in the deed from Lawrence B. Garrison to W. R. Payne, dated March 16, 1901, recorded in Deed Book GGG, page 818, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.

BEGINNING at a large poplar 3x on the branch; thence down the branch as a line 32 chains to a beech 3xo; thence S. 16-3/4 W. 12.50 to a stone 3xo; thence S. 5 W. 11.45 to stake 3xo; thence East 5.93 to B. O. stump 3xo; thence S. 44 1/2 E. 8.29 to P. O. 3xo; thence N. 55 1/2 E. 23.00 to the beginning corner.

Said tract of land contains forty-nine and one-half (49 1/2) acres, more or less, and is situated on the waters of Saluda River, about one-half mile from Grove Station, and is the same tract of land conveyed to Eliza A. Cason to her son and daughter, Maggie Wright and J. A. Major, by her deed dated March 18, 1922, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in deed book 74, page 286. The said Maggie Wright (now Maggie Wright Davis) acquired the title to J. A. Major's interest from his wife, Eva G. Major, the said J. A. Major, having died leaving his will on file in Anderson County, devising all his interest in the said land to his said wife, Eva G. Major; said land is bounded by lands now or formerly of Cleveland, Mrs. Cason, and others.
