all that tract or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being composed of two lots containing in the aggregate approximately 3/4 of an acre, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a black gum tree at the southerly corner of the tract of land conveyed to Grover D. Altman by deed dated November 30, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 229 at page 227 and running thence in a general easterly direction 200 feet to an iron stake in private road; thence along said private road in a general northerly direction 150 feet to an iron stake; thence in a general westerly direction to an iron stake on boundary line between lands of Grover D. Altman and lands of W. C. Bramlett, said stake being 150 feet from the beginning black gum tree; thence along line of lands of said W. C. Bramlett 150 feet to the beginning corner. Said land is bounded on the north by lands of Grover D. Altman, on the east by private road belonging to said Grover D. Altman, on the south by property of Grover D. Altman, and on the west by property of W. C. Bramlett.
