SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said J. M. Brown

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to The Liberty Life Insurance Company a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of THIRTY-FIVE HUNDRED

AND NO/100 (\$ 3,500.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at its Home Office in Greenville, together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, said principal and interest, being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 5th day of October, 1941 and on the 5th day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 27.69 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to including the 5th day of August, 1956 and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 5th day of September, 1956; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 27.69 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 3,500.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part thereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. M. Brown in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Liberty LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to me

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the northwest side of Augusta Place Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 21 on plat of Augusta Place made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May, 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book F, at page 129, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton June 20, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwest side of Augusta Place Street at joint front corner of Lots No. 20 and 21, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 20 N. 26-30 W. 181.8 feet to a stake; thence N. 63-30 E. 60 feet to a stake on the west side of Augusta Place Street; thence with the west side of Augusta Place Street S. 26-30 E. 116.3 feet to a stake; thence along a curved line with the west and north-west side of Augusta Place Street to a stake, the chord of which is S. 16-01 W. 89 feet, the beginning comer.
