TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: **I, W. R. Wilson, Jr.,** of **Greenville, South Carolina**, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **The Liberty Life Insurance Company**, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of **the State of South Carolina**, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of

Twenty-five hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$ **2500.00**), with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum (**4 1/2** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **The Liberty Life Insurance Company** in **Greenville South Carolina** or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Fifteen and 83/100** Dollars (\$ **15.83**), commencing on the first day of **January**, 19 **42** and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **December** 19 **61**.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the south side of Rogers Avenue, in Greenville Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, known and delineated as Lot #24 of the Gaer property sub-division as shown by plat of same recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in plat book G at page 237 and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Rogers Ave., at joint corner of lots #24 and 25, which iron pin measures 395 feet east from the southeastern intersection of Pine Street and Rogers Ave., and running thence along the south side of Rogers Ave., N. 83-55 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at joint corner of Lots 23 and 24; thence along line of lot 23 S. 5-50 E. 150.5 feet to iron pin at rear joint corner of lots 23 and 24; thence S. 83-55 W. 50 feet to iron pin at joint rear corner of lots 24 and 25; thence along the line of lot 25 N. 4-50 W. 150.5 feet to the point of beginning on Rogers Avenue.
