Whereas, I the said Kathryn C. Harling
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, I am
well and truly indebted to Louie E. Smith

in the full and just sum of One Hundred and sixty nine and 99/100
(\$169.99) Dollars, to be paid on September 30, 1944 in full, with the
right to anticipate, either wholly or in part, at any time before maturity

with interest thereon from September 30, 1943 at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 41, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue at Joint front corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25, said pin also being 352.4 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of Bates Avenue intersects with the Northwest side of Webster Road, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24, N. 65-43 E. 188.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-0 W. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 26, S. 55-35 W. 162.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue; thence with the Northeast side of Bates Avenue, S. 28-39 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
