SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, **I** the said **Ida G. Cohen** as
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these presents, **am**
well and truly indebted to **B. P. Edwards**

in the full and just sum of **Four Undred Two**
(\$402.00) Dollars, to be paid **at the rate of \$10.00 per months** for
eleven months, beginning Nov. 1, 1943, and the balance then remaining due in twelve months from
date

with interest thereon from **date of Edwards** at the rate of **7** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **annually**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Greer and Frances Jane S. Greer Estates, as shown on sub-division and plat made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on Dec. 1 and 2, 1941, which plat is of record in the RMC office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, page 67, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, and courses and distances, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin at joint corner of tracts 5 and 6, and in line of the W. C. Chandler land, and running thence along said Chandler line S. 2-20 W. 280 ft. to an iron pin; thence continuing along the Chandler line S. 73-45 E. 355 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 35-30 E. 375.5 ft. to a point in center of highway leading to Greer and at corner of tract #1; thence along the center of said highway, and along the line of said Tract #1 N. 2 W. 87.7 ft. to corner of tract #4; thence along the line of tract #4 S. 80-20 W. 373.8 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 79-40 W. 200 ft. to the point of beginning, and being the same tract deeded to me by E.
