all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in subdivision known as Junction Heights, just outside the corporate limits of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 30 on plat of said Junction Heights as shown on Plat Book "C" at page 106, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat:

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Center Street, joint corner of Lots 29 and 30, said point being 200 feet from the intersection of Center Street and Parker Road, and running thence with line of Lot 19 S. 37-06 E. 150 feet to corner of Lot No. 21; thence with the rear line of Lot 21 N. 62-30 E. 50 feet to corner of Lot 31; thence with line of Lot 31 N. 37-06 W. 150 feet to Center Street; thence with Center Street S. 62-30 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
