I, Doris M. Hughie (formerly Doris M. Balentine) SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, Doris M. Hughie

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of FOUR THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$ 4,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of THIRTY-TWO AND NO/100
(\$ 32.00) Dollars upon the first

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
