Beginning at an iron pin, the south-east corner, and running thence N. 32 1/2 W. 18.72 chains to a w. o. tree on; thence N. 52 W. 12.10 to an iron pin; thence S. 15 W. 12.75 to a stone n.m; thence S. 48 W. 4.30 to stake at Greenville Power line; thence with power line S. 24 E. 5.23 to stake; thence N. 62 1/2 E. 2.50 to stake; thence S. 74 E. 8.08 to stone thence N. 80 E. 3.53 to pine n.m; thence S. 86 E. 3.20 to scurwood xnm; thence S. 55 E. 6.07 to stake; thence N. 77 E. 2.37 to beginning corner and containing 26 3/4 acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to Elzy Robinson by H. D. Burns, et al, by deed recorded in book 269, page 47.

W. tree x 3 nm; thence S. 32 1/2 E. 18.72 chains to an iron post nm; thence S. 61 1/2 E. 4.95 chains to an iron post in the margin of the Marietta and Pickens Road; thence N. 33 E. 3 chains with the margin of the Marietta and Pickens Road to an iron post, the beginning corner, containing 14 3/4 acres, more or less, as shown by plat drawn by W. A. Heat registered surveyor, dated September 22, 1937, being same tract of land conveyed to Elzy Robinson by Herman A. Gudger deed recorded in book 202, page 23.

It is understood that when Elzy Robinson purchased the tract of land last above described that a right of way was reserved across the same for the purpose of ingress and egress to other lands owned by the said Herman A. Gudger.
