on the 13th day of June, 1946, and a like amount on the 13th day of each and every succeeding month  
thereafter, until paid in full; with the right to anticipate, however, by the payment of all or any  
part thereof before due,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to  
become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should  
be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection  
of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either  
of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mort-

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, in Greenville County, State of  
South Carolina, on the south side of the old Spartanburg Road, and, according to survey and plat  
made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, April 6, 1946, recorded in Plat Book "B" at page 137, R.M.C. Office  
for Greenville County, having the following metes and bounds to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a point on said old Spartanburg Road, at corner of Graves land, and running  
thence along the line of said Graves land, S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 504 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along  
said Graves line S. 46 E. 432 feet to iron pin; thence N. 62 E. 210 feet to a point in the western  
line of a 9.07 acre tract as shown on and by said plat; thence N. 39 W. 935 feet along the western  
line of said 9.07 acre tract, to a point on old Spartanburg Road; thence S. 64 W. 210 feet along
