We, Milton J. Karelitz and Muriel D. Karelitz, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS we the said Milton J. Karelitz and Muriel D. Karelitz

in and by OUR certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of FIVE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED

AND NO/100 - - - - - four and one-half (4 1/2%)

(\$ 5,400.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FORTY-ONE AND NO/100

(\$ 41.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we Milton J. Karelitz and Muriel D. Karelitz

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the point where the southwest side of Bates Avenue intersects with the northwest side of Webster Road, and running thence along the southwest side of Bates Avenue, N. 47-05 W. 62.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence along the line of Lot No. 20, S. 42-57 W. 152.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50-27 E. 51 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-23 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner." Being the same lot conveyed to us by James H. Floyd and Eula K. Floyd by deed of even date herewith not yet recorded.

It is understood and agreed that should this property be sold and transferred to any purchaser or purchasers who are not veterans of World War 2, then the mortgagee herein shall have the right to declare the amount due hereunder immediately after said transfer and sale.
