receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. A. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, School District 7-6, located on the west side of the Batesville - Five - Forks Road, and containing 15.16 acres, more or less, and having according to a survey and plat made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on March 6, 1945, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of the Batesville Road at the corner of property of the R. M. McGee estate and I. D. Ford, and running thence along the line of the Batesville Road N. 4-30 W. 138.5 feet to a bend in said road; thence still with the line of said road, N. 10-45 E. 616 feet to a post oak on the west side of said road, at the corner of property of Mrs. W. T. Adams thence along the line of the Adams property, N. 71-30 W. 321 feet to an iron pin at the corner of the Adams and E. M.
