BEGINNING on a large poplar on the East side of the Greenville Highway, said poplar being about 1000 feet South of the old Thompson Store Building, and running thence with said Greenville Highway, N. 40-45 W. 600 feet to a stake. Thence leaving the road and running thence N. 40-30 E. 230 feet to a point where a small branch runs into Fall Creek. Thence up and with the center of said branch as follows:

N. 51 E. 117 feet, N. 71-30 E. 75 feet N. 39-40 E. 65 feet N. 47 E. 91 feet, N. 41 E. 117 feet N. 59 E. 94 feet N. 21-30 E. 100 feet N. 34 E. 159 feet N. 48 E. 116 feet. Thence leaving the branch and running a hollow N. 55 E. 78 feet, Thence N. 65 E. 81 feet. Thence N. 57 E. 75 feet Thence S. 60 E. 150 feet to a small poplar in the M. R. Bell line.
