piece, parcel all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. about two and one-half miles West of Greenville Court House and fronting on the South side of the Bramlett Road, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of said Road at corner of property formerly known as negro church property; thence with said property S. 11-45 E. 120 feet to corner of property formerly owned by J. A. Burns, which corner is also the Southwest corner of lot hereafter described: thence N. 59-30 E. 60 feet, more or less, to center of Willis Avenue (formerly Gentry Street); thence along said Street in a Southwesterly direction 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the West side of said Street; thence S. 71-45 W. 76 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-45 W. 225 feet to a stake on Bramlett Road; thence with said Road N. 71-15 E. 75 feet to the beginning.

ALSO, -That certain lot adjoining the above described lot, being situate on the West side of Willis Avenue (formerly Gentry Street), and described as follows:

BEGINNING 100 feet from a pipe on new cut road or Bramlett Road; thence S. 11-45 E. 35 feet to a stake; thence with line of Lot above described S. 59-30 W. crossing the Road 72 feet to a pipe; thence continuing with said Lot N. 11-45 W. 35 feet to a stake; thence N. 59-30 E. 72 feet to the beginning. Said Lot being known as Lot No. 1 of property of A. G. New as shown on Plat by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor.
