Lindsay in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee Citizens Lumber Company, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee Citizens Lumber Company, and its successors xxxHax and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township Greenville County, State aforesaid, on the Southern side of Pendleton Street in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 1 on Plat of property of Nellie H. Mackey made by R. E. Dalton in December 1921, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 20, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Pendleton Street, 106.6 feet East from Sumner Street at corner of Lot No. 2, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 20-20 W. 172.2 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of said lot, S. 70-27 E. 102.7 feet to a stake in line of property now or formerly owned by Ella W. Hard; thence with the line of said property N. 19-23 E. 172.7 feet to a stake on Pendleton Street; thence with the Southern side of Pendleton Street, N. 70-48 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
