Also, All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the northwest intersection of Buncombe Street and Laurens Street, designated as Lot No. 13 on plat of Rush Brothers as shown on plat R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated January, 1924, recorded in Plat Book F, Page 181, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southwest side of West North Street and running thence S. 20-05 W. 40 feet; thence N. 69-07 W. 20 feet; thence N. 20-04 E. 40 feet to North Street; thence with North Street S. 69-07 E. 20 feet to the beginning corner.
