MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Rose Lee M. Moser

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

One Thousand and No/100 - - - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 1,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of Block B as shown on plat of the property of Alice M. Willis and H. H. Willis, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J" at Page 151 (see also Plat Book "K" at Page 271, and being more particularly described, according to said Plat, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of Arch Street and Gentry Street(formerly Willis Avenue), and running thence with Gentry Street, N. 45-45 E. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 27; thence with the joint lines of said lots, S. 53-15 E. 249 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 25 ; thence with the joint lines of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, S. 36-15 W. 221.3 feet to an iron pin on Arch Street; thence with Arch Street N. 27 W. 296 feet to the beginning corner, containing 0.93 acres, more or less."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by H. H. Willis and Alice M. Willis by deed dated February 7, 1944, recorded in Volume 261 at Page 281.
