All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the east side of the New Buncombe Road, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a pin on the east side of the New Buncombe Road, at the northwest corner of the lot heretofore conveyed by G. A. Neal to Cason, and running thence with the line of the Cason lot 250 feet, more or less, to pin on west side of Cherrydale Drive; thence along the west side of Cherrydale Drive in a northerly direction 200 feet, more or less, to a pin, corner of land now or formerly owned by Murphy; thence with the last mentioned line in a westerly direction 250 feet, more or less, to pin on the east side of the New Buncombe Road; thence along the east side of the New Buncombe Road and in a southerly direction 200 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

The above described lot of land is the same that was conveyed to T. C. Ramey by G. A. Neal by deed dated May 14, 1935, and recorded in Book 180, page 242. T. C. Ramey died intestate March 18, 1944, and the mortgagors are his wife and daughter.
