All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and on the North side of Kenwood Lane, (formerly known as Heston Avenue) near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot number 79, on Plat of North Park made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1940, revised February 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "K", at pages 48 and 49, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Kenwood Lane at joint front corner of Lots 79 and 80 and running thence with the line of lot 80, N. 19-06 E. 168 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot 91, S. 68-52 E. 58 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-20 W. 169.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Kenwood Lane; thence with the North side of Kenwood Lane N. 68-34 W. 57.5 feet to the beginning corner.
