Whereas, I, the said Royale Carter

in and by my said Royale Carter, in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly delivered to First National Bank of Greenville, S.C.

as Trustee of the Estate of H. C. Hagan in the full and just sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100 (\$1500.00) Dollars, to be paid \$100.00 on principal on the 31st day of each month hereafter, beginning August 31, 1948, and \$100.00 on the 31st day of each successive month thereafter until paid in full.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgage, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Mortgagee, in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and its successors, heirs and assigns forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in

Stutt Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, adjoining lands now or formerly of G. C. Good, Southern Railroad, W. H. Freeman, L. M. Cochran and G. A. Ellis, and containing 10 acres, more or less, according to survey made by J. N. Southern on October 1st, 1910, and having the following notes and bounds, according to plat of property made by C. M. Fugate, Jr., Regr., March, 1932.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the road leading from Greenville, S.C. to Piedmont, S.C., joint corner of property now or formerly owned by L. L. Carter, formerly owned by C. C. Good, and running thence S. 75-40 E. 17 chains to an iron pin on what is now or formerly G. A. Ellis' line; thence N. 22-45 E. 2.10 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 78 W. 8.36 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 95-30 W. 12 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 15-30 W. 6 chains to an iron pin; thence with said Greenville-Piedmont Highway S. 1-15 N. 12 chains to the beginning.

ALSO, All that other certain piece, parcel or strip of land sixteen (16) feet wide, beginning at the corner of land of G. A. Ellis and land of Mrs. L. M. Cochran, on the White Horse Road, said corner being in front of the house now or formerly owned by Dr. R. D. Smith, at which stands a power pole; said strip of land to run parallel with the line of G. A. Ellis and Mrs. L. M. Cochran's land and to extend to the property above described. This being the same strip of land conveyed to W. H. Green by G. A. Ellis, by deed recorded Volume 95 at Page 298.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagee by S. H. Halving, Jr., as Committee for Raleigh S. Barnhart by deed dated December 21, 1933, recorded in Volume 249 at page 345.
