called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of One-thousand, fifty, and no/100

Dollars (\$ 1,050.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of four per centum ( 4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Six and 36/100

Dollars (\$ 6.36 ), commencing on the first day of September, 19 48, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of August, 19 68.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, Gantt Township State of South Carolina; known and designated as Lot No. 27 according to plat

of property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 7:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Glennwood Lane, joint front corner of Lot No. 26 and running thence along line of Lot No. 26, N. 33-12 E. 181.2 feet to iron pin in line of Lot No. 30; thence with line of Lots 30 and 29 S. 75-57 W. 110.8 feet to iron pin, joint front corner of Lot No. 28; thence with line of Lot No. 28, S. 30-19 W. 102.3 feet to iron pin on Glennwood Lane; thence along Glennwood Lane S. 58-35 E. 70 feet to beginning corner.
