All that piece, parcel or lot of land with two buildings thereon in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing two and sixty-five one-hundredths (2.65) acres, more or less, lying and being situated in Eastview School District, and being known as lot number one (1) of the H. P. Beam Subdivision, said plat made in September 1947 by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at corner of J. W. King's land in center of public road, thence along J. W. King, Jr. line N. 18-0 E. 241 feet to joint corner of King and Beam lines; thence along line of H. P.
