NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, known as a part of the Old Shockly Home Place, located on the Hunt's Bridge Road, approximately 8 miles from Greenville and having, according to a plat made by J. C. Hill in August 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a public road, at corner of property now or formerly owned by W. W. Gibson, and running thence along the center of public road, S. 85 E. 231 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said road, N. 50 E. 254 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-20 E. 778 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54-15 W. 589 feet to a point in center of spring; thence S. 8 E. 745 feet to stake; thence N. 41-45 W. 938 feet to W.O.; thence N. 28-30 E. 726 feet to W.O. stump; thence N. 17-30 E. 467.94 feet to the point of beginning."
