

, to be paid \$100.00 per month until paid in full

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, and improvements theron, lying and being situate on the Buncombe Road near the Villiage of Travelers Rest in a subdivision known as "Love Estate" and being known and described on the plat thereof as lot number 42. The said plat here referred to is recorded in the Ofrice of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book I, pages 111 and 112. This lot is specifically described by courses and distances, to-wit:-
