and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on thels_tday
of April 1957, and on the day of each month thereafter the
sum of \$75to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue
up to and including thestday ofEebruary, 1982_, and the balance
of said principal sum to be due and payable on the laineday of march, 1942;
the aforesaid monthly payments of \$75_50each are to be applied first to interest at the rate
of 5-3/4 per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$12000.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.
