cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal  
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said **General R. Heywood,**

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and  
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Clyde A. Walker, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 4  
as shown on a plat of a portion of Ed Robinson Estate by R. K. Campbell  
and J. L. Hunter, dated February 11, 1956, recorded in Plat Book \_\_\_\_\_,  
Page \_\_\_\_\_, Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville  
County, the said portion of said estate being a part of the ten acre  
parcel more or less as noted in Deed Vol. 194, page 39, and being more  
particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Ernest Tathem, Ed Robinson line at  
the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 4, and running along said line,  
S. 6-30 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos.  
5 and 4; thence along the line of division of Lots Nos. 4 and 5,  
N. 83-30 W., 180 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos.
