All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being more particularly described as Lot No. 164, Section I, as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision of Village Houses, F. W. Poe Manufacturing Company, Greenville, S. C." made by Dalton & Neves, July 1950, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y at pages 26-31 inclusive, and according to said plat the within described lot is also known as Lot No. 12, Fifth Avenue, and is described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern corner of the intersection of Fifth Avenue and B.
