(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY

DOLLARS (\$ 2,350.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per céntum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oneal Township, near Sandy Flat and about two miles from Double Springs Baptist Church, being a part of the subdivision of the W.S. Dill property, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the east bank of road that leads from the old Buncombe Road to the Groce Meadow Road, and runs thence N. 13½ E. 198 feet to a stake on the Davenport-Collins line; thence S. 49 E. 360 feet to a stone; thence S. 21¼ W. 116 feet to a stone on Roy Collins line; thence S. 18¼ W. 1240 feet to a stake on said road; thence along the east bank of the road in a northerly direction to the beginning corner, containing seven (7) acres, more or less, and being all of that property as conveyed to the mortgagor by R.C. Blackwell by deed dated December 11, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 367, at page 257.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
