C. Hill in March 1958, is described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeastern corner of the intersection of Brockman Avenue and Young Street, and running thence with Brockman Avenue, N. 10-30 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 75-55 W. 102.8 feet to an iron in In line of lot # 43; thence S. 16-20 W. 87.6 feet to an iron pin on Young Street; thence with said Street, N. 57-25 W. 101 feet to the point of beginning.
